How do we remember important things? Engage all our senses! Jesus knew that it would be easy for his followers to lose hope and lose the way he taught them to live and love. So on the night before he was arrested, he sat at a big table with the companions on the journey and shared bread and wine, hand to hand, and asked them to come together and do the same, and he promised to meet them there, to BE there. He also put a towel around his waist and knelt on the floor and went from person to person and washed their dirty feet with great love. He asked them to do as he did: to love sacrificially and lavishly. Jesus wanted them and us to remember him experientially and know him energetically. We

know Jesus is present when we gather together in love, meet him around the table, receive his spirit through bread and wine shared, and go out with our neighbors to love as Jesus loved. It is a great Gift and Mystery.

Live in the present. Prepare intelligently for the future and leave the past alone. This is what Jesus meant when he said, "let the dead bury the dead" (Matt. 8:22). touch mentally any negative thing that has happened up to the present moment and keep the law. Life is too precious for grave robbing. The past is past: liquidate it. If a negative memory comes into your mind, cremate it with the right thought (the fire of Love) and forget it.


